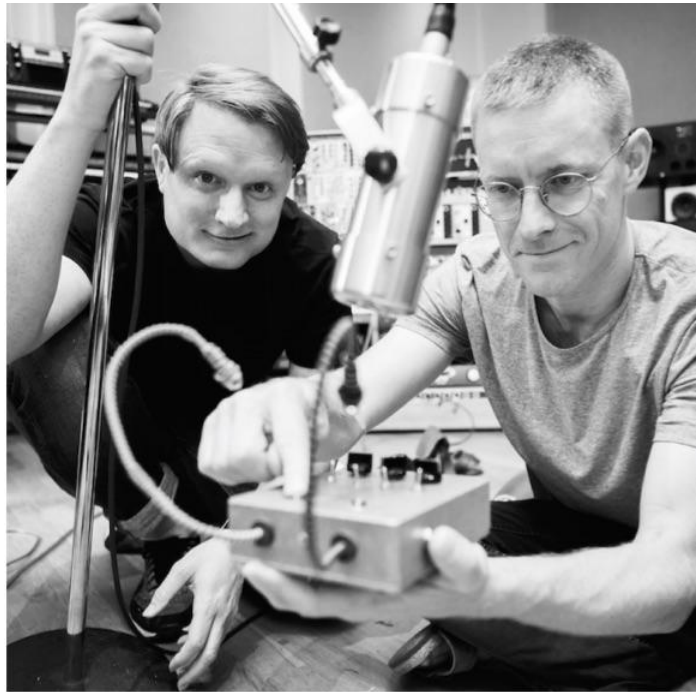




BRAINS AND HUNCH
